








**EMERGENCY BRACING POSITIONS**

**FRONT FACING SEATS**

- SEAT BELT SNUGLY FASTENED WITH SHOULDER HARNESS ATTACHED
- SEAT BACK UPRIGHT OR PER WINDOW PLACARD
- HEADREST FULLY EXTENDED
- CHIN ON CHEST
- HANDS CLASPED TOGETHER ACROSS MIDDLE

**AFT FACING SEATS**

- SEAT BELT SNUGLY FASTENED WITH SHOULDER HARNESS ATTACHED
- SEAT UPRIGHT, HEADREST FULLY EXTENDED
- BODY FLAT AGAINST SEATBACK AND HEADREST
- HANDS CLASPED TOGETHER ACROSS MIDDLE
